

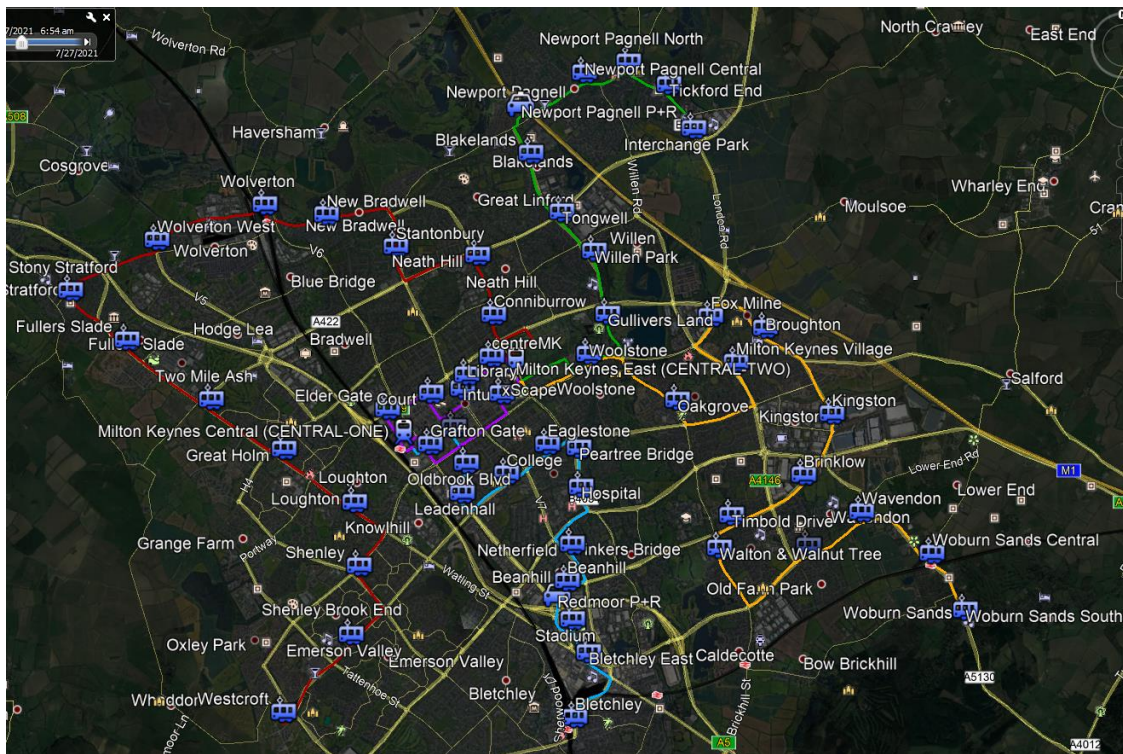


MK:Tram
